

## Chapter CV PEO Memorial Scholarship

### Eligibility

Any female Prairie View, Pleasanton or Jayhawk Linn High School student who is a graduating senior is eligible to apply for this scholarship. **Exceptions:** Daughters and granddaughters of PEO members are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.

### Information

The PEO Memorial Scholarship is for \$250.00 for two applicants and is sponsored by Chapter CV, LaCygne.

The recipient will be selected on the basis of scholarship, character and need. Emphasis will be given to students that have shown participation in school activities, community activities, and church.

The funds will be presented following completion of the student's fall enrollment. To be eligible, the student must enroll in an accredited four year university, college, two year junior college, or trade school. The funds may be used for books, tuition, and other necessities required for college enrollment.

If, for any reason, the student should not enroll in a post-secondary school by October 1, the award will be forfeited and presented to the student selected as an alternate.

The decision of the PEO Scholarship Committee shall be final.

### Procedure for Applying

The application form and other information is available from your guidance counselor.

Application forms, including a copy of your high school transcript must be completed and returned to your guidance counselor by April 4th.
