

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS
TO
CLYDE W. HALL SCHOLARSHIP

1. The applicant or applicants will be selected from the Pleasanton High School commencing with 1983 school year. Based upon available funds, scholarships may be applied for or renewed on a calendar basis providing semester attendance in consecutive. In case funds are not available to support the intended dollar amount of this scholarship, then a prorated system of allocation may be utilized. It will be the responsibility of the Scholarship Committee to arrive at the decision of the amount of prorated funds.
2. The applicant must be planning to attend as a full time student a state accredited educational institution with an approved program. (Full time student as verified by institution.)
3. The applicant's scholarship or aptitude ability to succeed in a post graduate training shall be examined by the Scholarship Committee. (It is recommended that the high school guidance counselor sit as a consultant on this Scholarship Committee.)
4. First time applicants who are planning on attending a college or university must have taken the ACT test or comparable test prior to completion of their senior year and submit the results with the application to the Scholarship Committee. A high school transcript must also be submitted to the Scholarship Committee.
5. The applicant must submit to the Scholarship Committee a completed application form before May 1st preceding the proposed scholarship year. Application forms may be obtained at the Pleasanton High School guidance office in Pleasanton, Kansas.
6. Those who have a need may have priority over those of equal qualifications with less financial need.
7. Once the scholarship has been awarded, the award may be renewable for 4 consecutive undergraduate years, provided the student has maintained a 2.0 GPA each semester and no failing grades, and is in good standing with the institution he/she is attending.
8. The final decision of the Committee will be based on scholastic achievement, over all citizenship characteristics and financial needs.
9. Scholarship amounts may be granted in any amount from a minimum of \$500.00 to a maximum of \$2000.00 per year at the sole option and discretion of the trustees. The trustees may take into consideration in fixing the amount of the scholarship, the recommendation of the Scholarship Committee, or their duly appointed representative. Scholarship amounts will be awarded on a semester basis.
10. Any attempt by applicant or applicant's family to influence a committee member or the committee as a whole as the awarding of a scholarship may subject the application to disqualification.
