

Wayne J. Miller and Beula Miller Trust Estate Scholarship

1. Information about the Trust

Wayne J. Miller and Beula A. Ackerman Miller established the trust for scholarships to graduates of United School District #344 (Pleasanton) and Unified School District # 346 (Jayhawk) or former high schools located within the two districts.

The scholarships are to assist deserving persons to obtain an education or training in a lawful trade, profession or occupation of their choice.

Scholarships recipients are determined by the trustees of the estate based upon merits of the applications. Scholarships can be renewed on a year to year basis by application for up to four or more years depending upon the educational or vocational plans of the student.

2. History of the Estate

Wayne J. Miller and Beula A. Ackerman Miller lived in the Prescott area. Mr. Miller, age 91 died on February 18, 2000 and his wife died on August 25, 1988.

Mr. Miller taught school for six years after graduating from high school. He then devoted his time to farming and livestock production. He was a member of the Prescott United Methodist Church, Farmers Home Administration Board, Soil Conservation Board, ASC Board, Prescott State Bank Board and the Prescott Country View Nursing Home Board.

Application Process
